AN ACT to authorize the county court of Summers county to expend funds for purchase of a site for the location of a Four-H camp in Summers county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Purchase of Site for Summers County Four-H*  
2 *Camp.* The county court of Summers county is hereby authorized to expend from any funds available, a sum not to  
3 exceed two thousand dollars for the purpose of purchasing  
4 a site for a suitable location for a Four-H camp; the above  
5 site to be located in Summers county.
