AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Braxton county to transfer the unexpended balances in the dog tax fund to the general county fund of said county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Braxton County Authorized to Transfer Funds.*

2 The county court of Braxton county is hereby authorized  
3 and empowered to transfer the unexpended balances now  
4 in the dog tax fund of said county, remaining and not needed  
5 for the payment and satisfaction of all claims and expenses  
6 against the said dog tax fund, to the general fund of said  
7 of said county.

8 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby  
9 repealed, insofar as they may apply to Braxton county.
