# House Bill No. 411

[Passed March 4, 1939; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section twenty, chapter sixty-seven, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-five, relating to application of state civil service to the fire department of Parkersburg, and abolishing the civil service commission for the city of Bluefield.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section twenty, chapter sixty-seven, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-five, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 20. *Firemen's Civil Service Act to Apply to City*  
2 of Parkersburg. The provisions of this act shall also apply  
3 in their entirety to the municipality of Parkersburg, notwith-  
4 standing any exception heretofore made as to said munici-  
5 pality; and the civil service commission granted for the mu-

6 nicipality of Bluefield under an act of the Legislature, regu-  
7 lar session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, is hereby  
8 abolished.

**I certify that the foregoing act, having been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislature in which it originated within the time prescribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.**
