AN ACT to repeal chapter forty-eight, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirteen, authorizing judge of former twenty-third circuit to appoint court stenographer and page.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Repeal of Act.* Chapter forty-eight, acts of the  
2 Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand  
3 nine hundred thirteen, authorizing the judge of the then  
4 twenty-third judicial circuit, now the seventeenth judicial  
5 circuit, to appoint a court stenographer and page, is hereby

6 repealed. Nothing herein contained shall refer or apply to  
7 the present twenty-third circuit consisting of Jefferson,  
8 Berkeley and Morgan Counties.
