AN ACT to authorize the county court of Wetzel county to expend funds for purchase of a site for the location of a Four-H camp in Wetzel county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Purchase of Site for Wetzel County Four-H*
2 *Camp.* The county court of Wetzel county is hereby author-
3 ized to expend from any funds available, a sum not to exceed
4 the amount of three thousand five hundred dollars for the
5 purpose of purchasing a site for a suitable location for the
6 future establishment of a Four-H camp; the above site to be
7 located in Wetzel county.
