[Passed March 3, 1939; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-t, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the time of terms of the circuit court for the counties of Randolph and Upshur.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-t, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1-t. *Terms of Court in Twentieth Judicial Circuit.* For the county of Randolph, on the third Tuesday in

3 February and May, and the second Tuesday in October.

4 For the county of Upshur, on the second Monday in

5 January, April and September.
