(BY MR. HALL)

[Passed March 3, 1939; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Lincoln
county to transfer the unexpended balances in the dog tax
fund to the general county fund of said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Lincoln County Authorized to Transfer Funds.*

- 2 The county court of Lincoln county is hereby authorized and
3 empowered to transfer the unexpended balances now in the
4 dog tax fund of said county, remaining and not needed for
5 the payment and satisfaction of all claims and expenses against

6 the said dog tax fund, to the general county fund of said
7 county.

8 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby
9 repealed, insofar as they may apply to Lincoln county.

I certify that the foregoing act,
having been presented to the Governor for
his approval, and not having been returned
by him to the House of the Legislature in
which it originated within the time pre-
scribed by the constitution of the state, has
become a law without his approval.
