[Passed March 2, 1939 ; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to provide a moratorium for reports required to be made
by the state commissioner of forfeited lands and for the institution and prosecution of suits for the sale of forfeited lands.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Reports by State Commissioner of Forfeited*
2 *Lands, Suits for Sale of Forfeited Lands.*—Notwithstanding
3 the provisions of sections eight and ten, of article three,
4 chapter thirty-seven of the code of West Virginia, as last
5 amended, no report shall be made by the state commissioner
6 of forfeited lands to the circuit court of the various counties

7 respecting forfeited lands, and no suit shall be instituted or
8 prosecuted for the sale of forfeited lands until after the
9 thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-nine;
10 *Provided*, That such report may be made or such suit may be
11 instituted and prosecuted at any time at the instance and
12 request of the former owner or owners of any particular
13 tract or tracts of land, or of a redeemable interest or in-
14 terests therein, or such report may be made or such suit
15 may be instituted and prosecuted at any time at the express
16 direction and order of the court.
