AN ACT to amend and reenact section eighteen, article nine, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the adoption of the new method of street paving.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eighteen, article nine, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 18. Proceedings Liberally Construed and New

- 2 Method Cumulative.—In order to secure a speedy com-
- 3 pletion of the work at a reasonable cost, and the speedy
- 4 collection of the assessments after the time has elapsed
- 5 for their payments, proceedings with respect to improve-
- 6 ments shall be liberally construed by council or court,
- 7 and merely formal objections in such cases shall be dis-

- 8 regarded; and the adoption of the new method of paving
- 9 streets shall not be deemed to be the adoption of an
- 10 exclusive method but shall be deemed and construed as
- 11 the adoption of an available method additional to any
- 12 others which may have theretofore been available by
- 13 charter or general law or which may hereafter become
- 14 available.
