[Passed March 7, 1941; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of the county of Boone to pay James Midkiff a monthly sum for life, or to make a settlement with him, for permanent injuries received by him while in the employ of said board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Boone County Board of Education Authorized to Pay James Midkiff for Permanent Injuries Received While an Employee of Said Board.*—The board of education of the county of Boone is hereby authorized and empowered to pay James Midkiff a sum not to exceed twenty-five dollars per month during the remainder of his life as compensation for permanent injuries received by him in the year one thousand nine hundred thirty-four, while employed by said board as supervisor of busses and while in the discharge of his official duties.

11 The said board of education is further authorized and
12 empowered to pay the said James Midkiff at a rate not to
13 exceed twenty-five dollars per month dating from July
14 one, one thousand nine hundred thirty-four: *Provided,*
15 *however,* That in lieu of a monthly compensation as
16 herein provided, the board of education of said county
17 is hereby authorized, at its discretion, to compromise and
18 settle the claim of said James Midkiff.
