House Bill No. 316

(By MR. RICE)

[Passed March 1, 1941; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the transfer to the permanent improvement fund of the board of education of the county of Berkeley all unused funds collected for the retirement of school bonds of Hedgesville district of said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *State Sinking Fund Authorized to Transfer*
2 *Certain Funds.*—The state sinking fund commission of
3 West Virginia is hereby authorized and directed to re-
4 turn to the credit of the permanent improvement fund
5 of the board of education of the county of Berkeley all
6 funds collected in Hedgesville district of said county for
7 the retirement of school bonds of said district and re-
8 maining after all such bonds have been retired. Said fund
9 shall be used in the same manner as other funds now to
10 the credit of, or which may hereafter be placed to the

11 credit of, the permanent improvement fund of the board
12 of education of the county of Berkeley, but such funds
13 hereby authorized and directed to be transferred shall
14 be expended in Hedgesville district.

Sec. 2. *The Sheriff of Berkeley County Authorized to*
2 *Transfer Certain Funds.*—The Sheriff of Berkeley county
3 is authorized and directed to transfer to the permanent
4 improvement fund of the board of education of the county
5 of Berkeley all funds collected by him for the retirement
6 of school bonds in Hedgesville district. Said funds shall
7 be used in the same manner as other funds now to the
8 credit of, or which may hereafter be placed to the credit
9 of the permanent improvement fund of the board of edu-
10 cation of the county of Berkeley, but such funds hereby
11 authorized and directed to be transferred shall be ex-
12 pended in Hedgesville district.
