**House Bill No. 352**

(BY MR. MACE, by request)

[Passed March 8, 1941; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the state road commission of West Virginia to reimburse Portia Hamrick for money she paid to get her car repaired, which car was in a collision with a state road truck.

WHEREAS, In the year one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, while Portia Hamrick's car was being driven through the town of Webster Springs by her brother, Otha Hamrick, a licensed driver, a state road truck, driven by Bayard Cutlip, an employee of the said road commission, ran into and almost demolished said car; and

WHEREAS, The driver of the state road truck, in view of holding his job as driver of the truck, had the driver of the Portia Hamrick car arrested for reckless driving; and

WHEREAS, In a justices' court on the thirteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, the defendant was found

not guilty, which places the fault on the driver of the state road truck; and

WHEREAS, At that time the state road commission did not carry insurance on their equipment; therefore,

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. The state road commission of West Virginia

2 is hereby authorized and empowered to pay to Portia  
3 Hamrick a sum not to exceed two hundred ninety dollars  
4 and seventy-one cents, reimburse her for money expended  
5 by her to get her car repaired after it was in a collision  
6 with a truck owned and operated by the state road com-  
7 mission in the year one thousand nine hundred thirty-  
8 six.
