AN ACT to authorize the county court of Lewis county to lay a  
levy for and appropriate money to purchase, equip, maintain and support fire-fighting apparatus and equipment.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Lewis County Court Authorized to Levy and*  
2 *Expend Funds for Fire-Fighting Equipment.*—That the  
3 county court of Lewis county is hereby authorized and  
4 empowered to lay a levy for and appropriate money, payable out of the general county fund, toward the purchase,  
5 equipment, maintenance and support of fire-fighting  
6 apparatus and equipment in Lewis county.
