(By Mr. Gentry)

[Passed March 8, 1941; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the county court of Cabell county to provide for the care and maintenance of abandoned public cemeteries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Cabell County Court Authorized to Provide 2 Care and Maintenance for abandoned Cemeteries.—Where 3 public cemeteries have been abandoned and are no longer 4 used for burial purposes in the county of Cabell, the 5 county court of Cabell county may, upon the request of 6 ten citizens of the county, or upon its own motion, pro-7 vide such care and maintenance as it deems proper.

8 Nothing herein contained shall be construed as granting
9 authority for the rehabilitation, maintenance, or care of
10 any private cemetery or one connected with any church
11 organization, or religious sect.
