Senate Bill No. 174

(BY MR. RANDOLPH, MR. PRESIDENT)

[Passed March 5, 1941; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding thereto a new article, designated article eleven, providing for preference ratings to veterans on the written parts of examinations for positions in the departments of public assistance, health and unemployment compensation filled according to a non-partisan merit basis.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new article, designated article eleven to read as follows:

Article 11. Preference Rating of Veterans on Written Examinations on Non-Partisan Merit Basis.

Section 1. For the written part of the examinations
2 for positions in the departments of public assistance,
3 health and unemployment compensation, to be filled
4 according to non-partisan merit standards, a preference
5 of five points in addition to the regular numerical score
6 received on the written part of such examinations shall
7 be awarded to veterans.

8 For the purposes of this act, "veteran" shall mean any
9 person who has served in the armed, naval or air forces
10 of the United States during the Spanish American or
11 World War.

12 The aforesaid preference award shall be made appli-
13 cable only to the examinations held on and after the first
14 day of September, one thousand nine hundred forty-
15 one.
