AN ACT to amend and reenact section fourteen, article ten, chapter thirty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, providing for a method of arriving at the taxable premiums, fees, dues, and assessments of automobile mutual insurance companies licensed to transact business in this state.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section fourteen, article ten, chapter thirty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 14. *Taxes; Computation.* Every insurance com-

2 pany or association incorporated by or organized under  
3 the laws of any other state and licensed to transact busi-  
4 ness under this article shall be subject to such taxes as  
5 are now provided by law for mutual companies organized  
6 without this state. The taxable premiums used as a basis  
7 for such taxation shall include premiums on all business  
8 written or renewed and any fees, dues, or assessments  
9 collected during the calendar year, less only premiums  
10 actually returned upon the cancellation of policies.
