AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Greenbrier
county to settle the claim of Mabel Fulwider.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of the County of
2 Greenbrier is hereby authorized and empowered, at its
3 discretion, to compromise and settle the claim of Mabel
4 Fulwider, for injuries she received from the explosion of
5 a stove belonging to said board, while she was employed
6 as janitor in the Caldwell grade school, in White Sulphur
7 district of said Greenbrier county.
