AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article eight, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as last amended and reenacted by chapter one hundred thirty-three, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-nine, relating to the use of debt levies for current expenses, and prescribing certain limitations with respect thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article eight, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as last amended and reenacted by chapter one hundred thirty-three, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-nine, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article VIII. Levies.

Section 7. Increase of Current Expense Levies When

- 2 Debt Levies Not Required; Limitations.—If the allocation
- 3 made to a taxing unit for the purposes of debt incurred
- 4 prior to the adoption of the tax limitation amendment is
- 5 not required, in whole or in part, for the purposes of such
- 6 debt, the governing body may, with the prior written
- 7 approval of the tax commissioner, increase the rates al-
- 8 located for general current expenses by the amount not
- 9 required for debt purposes.
