AN ACT to amend article one, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section three-a, granting additional powers to county courts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article one, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section three-a, to read as follows:

Section 3-a. *County Courts Authorized to Construct*
2 *Sewers, Etc.* In addition to all other powers and duties

3 now conferred by law upon county courts, such courts are
4 hereby authorized and empowered to install, construct,
5 repair, maintain and operate water works, water mains,
6 sewer lines and sewage disposal plants in connection there-
7 with within their respective counties: *Provided, That*
8 such authority and power as herein conferred upon county
9 courts shall not extend into the territory within any
10 municipal corporation: *Provided, however, That* any
11 county court is hereby authorized to enter into contracts
12 or agreements with any municipality within the county,
13 or with a municipality in an adjoining county, with
14 reference to the exercise of the powers vested in such
15 court by this section.
