[Passed March 9, 1943; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the county court of Monongalia county
to use unexpended funds and surpluses in any fund of
said county for the purpose of creating a special fund for
the building of a new courthouse, or for enlarging, re-
modeling and improving the present courthouse, and to
expend for such purpose the fund so created.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Monongalia county is
2 hereby authorized and empowered from year to year to
3 use any unexpended funds of said county and any sur-
4 plus in any county fund for the purpose of creating a spe-
5 cial fund for the building of a new courthouse, or for
6 enlarging, remodeling and improving the present court-
7 house, and to expend for such purpose the fund so cre-
8 ated.
