AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Braxton county to transfer the sum of one thousand dollars from the general county fund to the dog tax fund of said county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Braxton County Court Authorized to Transfer Funds.*—The county court of Braxton county is hereby  
2 authorized and empowered to transfer the sum of one  
3 thousand dollars from the general county fund to the  
4 dog tax fund of said county.

6 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby  
7 repealed, insofar as they may apply to Braxton county.
