[Passed March 9, 1943; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT directing the disposition of the interest from the money and remittances from a fund appropriated by the United States government on June twenty-fifth, one thousand nine hundred eight, to pay the West Virginia National Guard from the time of the call until the date of muster into the service of the United States for the Spanish American War, by the payment thereof to the United Spanish War veterans of the state of West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Governor Trustee of Spanish American War

- 2 Fund; Investment of Fund; Payment of Claims; Unex-
- 3 pended Balance; Bond of Quartermaster; Use of Funds.—
- 4 That the governor of this state shall remain the trustee
- 5 of the Spanish American War fund, and that from and

6 after the passage of this act, the said trustee shall cause such fund to be invested in some security of the state of West Virginia or the United States government, bearing semi-annual interest, and that the interest on said fund be payable on the first of January and the first of July 11 in each and every year; and out of said fund there be 12 paid any just and properly audited and verified claim of any of the veterans entitled thereto who may hereafter 14 apply for same, and after paying any claims received 15 prior to the interest period each year the unexpended balance of the interest for each half year shall be paid to the quartermaster of the West Virginia State Association of the United Spanish War Veterans, to be used by him for the benefit of said veterans, accounting for as other funds of said veterans: Provided, That said quartermaster is required by the association to execute a surety bond for the proper application of and accounting for the funds so received: Provided further, That the 24 funds so paid shall be used for the legitimate expenses 25 of the department encampment.
