(By MR. TAYLOR of Mingo)

[Passed March 12, 1943; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the county court of Mingo county to use unexpended funds and surpluses in any fund of said county for the purpose of creating a special fund for the building of a new jail, or for remodeling and improving any appropriate building owned by said county for that purpose, and to expend such special fund so created for that purpose and/or to use such special fund, or any part thereof, for making improvements to the courthouse.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Mingo county is hereby
2 authorized and empowered from year to year to use any
3 unexpended funds of said county and any surplus in any
4 county fund for the purpose of creation of a special fund
5 for the building of a new jail, or for enlarging or remodel-
6 ing any suitable building the county may now have, and

7 to expend for such purpose the fund so created, or any
8 part thereof, and/or to use any part of the fund so created
9 for the purpose of remodeling or improving the existing
10 courthouse in said county.
