AN ACT authorizing the county court of Wyoming county to  
compensate R. F. Musgrave for services rendered under  
a decree of reference involving the accounts of a com-  
missioner of school lands of Wyoming county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

*Section 1. Wyoming County Court Authorized to Com-*

2 *pensate R. F. Musgrave.*—The county court of Wyoming  
3 county is authorized and empowered to pay from the  
4 general county fund of Wyoming county the sum of one  
5 thousand dollars to R. F. Musgrave for services rendered  
6 under a decree of reference involving the accounts of  
7 Paul E. Blackshear, former commissioner of school lands  
8 of Wyoming county, it having been determined by an  
9 order of the circuit court of Wyoming county, entered  
10 on February twenty-four, one thousand nine hundred

11 thirty-nine, that such services were rendered by the said  
12 R. F. Musgrave and that the sum of one thousand dol-  
13 lars be allowed as compensation for the services of the  
14 said R. F. Musgrave, and the county court of Wyoming  
15 county is directed to make provision in its next annual  
16 budget for the said payment.
