AN ACT to amend article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section ten-(a), relating to the adoption of textbooks by the state board of education.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section ten-(a), to read as follows:

Section 10-(a). The state board of education shall not  
2 hold any hearings or accept any bids or make any changes  
3 in the textbooks now under contract for use in the public  
4 schools of the state until the cessation of hostilities in  
5 which the United States of America is now engaged.
