(BY MR. LAFOLLETTE)

[Passed March 13, 1943; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article four, chapter eleven-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as enacted by chapter one hundred seventeen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-one, by adding thereto a new section to be numbered fifty-six, relating to disposition of sheriff's lists and sale of real estate for taxes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article four, chapter eleven-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as enacted by chapter one hundred seventeen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section fifty-six, to read as follows:

Section 56. In the event any part of this chapter be

2 declared to be unconstitutional to the end that the state
3 can not adequately dispose of real estate which is de-
4 linquent for nonpayment of taxes, forfeit for nonentry,
5 waste and unappropriated, escheated, or purchased by
6 the state whether redeemed or unredeemed and subject
7 to sale for the benefit of the school fund or which may
8 have been certified to and is now in the hands of the
9 auditor, the auditor shall complete his compilation of
10 such lands from any appropriations now or hereafter
11 made for the purpose and shall hold the same pending
12 future directions and an enactment of statutes by the
13 Legislature respecting the disposition thereof, and the
14 auditor in such event shall direct any and all deputy
15 commissioners to recertify to him any lands which may
16 be in their hands for disposal.
