AN ACT to amend and reenact section six-a, article eight, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended by chapter one hundred thirty-two, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-nine, relating to tax levies.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section six-a, article eight, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended by chapter one hundred thirty-two, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-nine, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 6-a. *Levies on Each Classification by the Board*

2 of *Public Works*. The state board of public works shall  
3 levy for general expense purposes, including the payment  
4 of the state debt, for the state fund general revenue, as  
5 provided by section eight, as follows:

6 On class I property, twenty-five hundredths of one  
7 cent; on class II property, five-tenths of one cent; and on  
8 classes III and IV property, one cent.

9 Whenever the state board of public works finds the  
10 revenues from all sources have been or will be insuf-  
11 ficient to meet the requirements for interest and sinking  
12 funds on state road bonds, said state board of public works  
13 shall levy for said purposes as provided by section eight,  
14 whatever rates of levy are necessary to meet the require-  
15 ments for interest and sinking funds on state road bonds  
16 issued prior to November eight, one thousand nine hun-  
17 dred thirty-two, which rates of levy shall be as follows:

18 On class I property, one cent; on class II property, two  
19 cents, and on classes III and IV property, four cents, or

20 multiples thereof or in like ratio, on all property subject to  
21 taxation in the state.

22 All acts, or parts of acts, in conflict with the provision  
23 of this act are hereby repealed.
