## House Bill No. 147

(By Mr. Moore)

[Passed March 6, 1945; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section six, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to allowances to circuit judges for stationery, postage and stenographic work.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 6. Allowances to Circuit Judges for Stationery,

- 2 Postage and Stenographic Work.—Each judge of the cir-
- 3 cuit court shall be reimbursed out of the state treasury for
- 4 the actual amounts expended by him for the procure-
- 5 ment of necessary stationery, the payment of postage, and
- 6 the payment for stenographic work, necessary in the dis-
- 7 charge of the duties of his office, not to exceed one hun-

- 8 dred dollars per month: Provided, That in the first
- 9 judicial circuit each judge shall be allowed not to ex-
- 10 ceed one hundred fifty dollars per month for such ex-
- 11 penses. Such sums shall be paid monthly out of the state
- 12 treasury, but not until the judge submits an itemized
- 13 statement covering the same.
- 14 All acts or parts of acts in conflict with and inconsist-
- 15 ent herewith are hereby repealed.
