House Bill No. 194

(By MR. HUGUS and MR. BURT)

[Passed March 6, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of commissioners of the county of Ohio to use all or part of debt levies, not required for bonded indebtedness, for the purpose of the construction, equipment and maintenance of an airport, and a county building, providing for the leasing of temporary quarters during the construction of any county building, and for the construction, equipment and maintenance of any county building in conjunction with the city of Wheeling, and validating and confirming levies heretofore laid for the purchase of lands for and the construction of an airport.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *The Board of Commissioners of the County of Ohio Authorized to Lay and Disburse Certain Levies.—*
2 of Ohio Authorized to Lay and Disburse Certain Levies.—
3 For a period of five years commencing with the fiscal year
4 one thousand nine hundred forty-five—one thousand nine

5 hundred forty-six, in addition to the levies heretofore
6 authorized to be laid by county courts for general county
7 current expense, and for the payment of interest and
8 sinking fund requirements on bonded indebtedness in-
9 curred subsequent to the passage of the tax levy limita-
10 tion amendment, the board of commissioners of the
11 county of Ohio is hereby authorized and empowered to
12 lay such additional levy as may not be required for
13 bonded indebtedness, on all of the property in Ohio
14 county, but not to exceed four and nine-tenths cents on
15 each one hundred dollars assessed valuation on class I
16 property; nine and eight-tenths cents on class II prop-
17 erty; and nineteen and six-tenths cents on class III and
18 IV property. The proceeds of said levy shall be placed
19 in a separate fund designated "Public Improvement
20 Fund," to be used solely for the construction, equipment
21 and maintenance of an airport, and a county building,
22 and for the leasing of temporary quarters for a county
23 building during any construction period. Any such
24 county building may be constructed, equipped and main-
25 tained in conjunction with the city of Wheeling. Such

26 levies heretofore laid by the board of commissioners of
27 the county of Ohio for the purpose of purchasing land
28 and constructing an airport thereon are hereby validated
29 and confirmed.

Sec. 2. All acts and part of acts inconsistent or in con-
2 flict herewith, insofar as the same may be applicable
3 to the county of Ohio, or the said board of commissioners
4 of the county of Ohio, are hereby repealed.
