AN ACT to permit members of the armed forces to hunt or  
fish without license while on leave or furlough.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Hunting and Fishing Licenses Not Required*  
2 of *Members of Armed Forces*.—All members of the armed  
3 forces of the United States of America shall have the  
4 rights and privileges of hunting and fishing in season  
5 without state or county Hunting and Fishing license  
6 while on leave or furlough. Leave or furlough papers  
7 shall serve in lieu of regularly issued state hunting and  
8 fishing license, in any county within the state of West  
9 Virginia.
