## ENROLLED House Bill No. 321

(By Mr. Evans)

[Passed March 10, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article one, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section fourteen, authorizing the state department of health to cooperate with the federal government in its hospital construction program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article one, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section four-teen, to read as follows:

## Article 1. State Department of Health.

Section 14. State Department of Health Authorized to

- 2 Cooperate with Federal Government in Hospital Con-
- 3 struction Program.—The state department of health is
- 4 hereby designated as the sole state agency to cooperate

- 5 with the federal government in its hospital construction
- 6 program; and is hereby authorized to make such an in-
- 7 ventory of existing public health centers and public and
- 8 private hospitals, and the laboratory and other facilities
- 9 thereof, and to adopt and supervise the administration of
- 10 such a state-wide plan for the construction of additional
- 11 hospitals and public health centers as may be necessary
- 12 to comply with the requirements and conditions of fed-
- 13 eral law in respect to the granting of federal aid for
- 14 such purposes.
- 15 The authority conferred by this section may be exer-
- 16 cised by the department of health only with the joint
- 17 approval of the commissioner of health and the public
- 18 health council. The governor shall have authority to ap-
- 19 point such an advisory council to consult with the de-
- 20 partment of health as may be necessary under federal
- 21 law to effectuate the purposes of this section. The mem-
- 22 bers of any such advisory council shall serve without
- 23 compensation, but shall be paid the amount of their
- 24 traveling and other expenses necessarily incurred in the
- 25 performance of their duties.
