[Passed March 10, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article nineteen, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding a new section thereto to be designated section thirteen-b, pertaining to the dumping of trash along the right-of-way of public highways.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article nineteen, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be further amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section thirteen-b, to read as follows:

Section 13-b. *Unlawful Dumping of Trash, etc., Upon
2 Right-of-Way of, or along, Public Highway; Penalty.—*
3 It shall be unlawful for any person to dump, unload
4 or place upon the berm or right-of-way of any public
5 highway, or upon the property adjacent thereto and

6 within three hundred feet thereof, without the written
7 consent of the owner, any trash, tin cans, garbage, or any
8 other type of waste products or refuse.

9 Any person violating the provisions of this section
10 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction
11 thereof shall be fined not less than five nor more than
12 fifty dollars.
