[Passed March 5, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter ninety-three, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven, relating to the salary of the judge and probation officers of the juvenile court of Kanawha county, and to amend and reenact section nine, chapter one hundred seventy-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-one, relating to the salary of the judge of the court of common pleas of Kanawha county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter ninety-three, acts of the Legislature of West

Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven, is hereby repealed and that section nine, chapter one hundred seventy-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-one, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 9. The judge of the court of common pleas of
2 Kanawha county shall receive for his services as such
3 eight thousand five hundred dollars per annum, payable
4 out of the county treasury of said county of Kanawha as
5 the salaries of the other officers of said county are paid,
6 beginning the first day of July, one thousand nine hun-
7 dred forty-five.
