Senate Bill No. 135

(BY MR. HALL, OF RALEIGH)

[Passed March 2, 1945; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the county courts of Preston, Raleigh and Ritchie counties to expend money for acquiring, developing and maintaining an airport or landing field within each of said counties and to cooperate with state and federal agencies for that purpose.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county courts of Preston, Raleigh and
2 Ritchie counties are hereby authorized to use general
3 county funds or any other funds at their disposal, and
4 which they are not required to spend for other purposes,

5 for acquiring, developing and maintaining airports or
6 landing fields within each of their said counties. The
7 said county courts are also authorized to cooperate with
8 any state or federal agencies or departments in acquiring,
9 developing and maintaining said airports or landing fields
10 and are authorized to accept state or federal funds, and
11 other gifts, devises and bequests for such purposes.
