ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 144

(By Mr. Bambrick)

[Passed February 23, 1945; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing and empowering the conservation commission of the State of West Virginia to lease a camp site within the Tomlinson's Run state park, in Clay district of Hancock county, to the Boy Scouts of America for the purpose of constructing, erecting and maintaining a boy scout camp therein.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- Section 1. The conservation commission of the State
- 2 of West Virginia is hereby authorized and empowered to
- 3 lease a camp site within the confines of the Tomlinson's
- 4 Run state park, situated in Clay district, Hancock county,

- 5 West Virginia, to the Boy Scouts of America for the pur-
- 6 pose of constructing, erecting and maintaining a boy
- 7 scout camp therein for the exclusive use of said Boy
- 8 Scouts of America; and said conservation commission of
- 9 the State of West Virginia is hereby authorized and em-
- 10 powered to enter into such lease agreement with the
- 11 Boy Scouts of America under such terms and conditions
- 12 as the commission shall deem proper. No such lease
- 13 shall be for any period longer than ninety-nine years.
