[Passed March 2, 1945; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the county court of Braxton county to
use unexpended funds and surpluses in the general fund
of said county for the purpose of creating a special fund
for the remodeling, enlarging, repairing and improving
the present jail of said county, and to expend such fund
for such purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Braxton county is here-
2 by authorized and empowered from year to year to use
3 any unexpended funds of said county and any surplus

4 in the general county fund for the purpose of creating
5 a special fund, not to exceed the sum of twenty thou-
6 sand dollars, for the remodeling, enlarging, repairing and
7 improving the present jail of said county, and to expend
8 such fund for such purposes.
