(By MR. BAMBRICK)

[Passed March 6, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT validating the use, by the county court of Hancock
county in prior years, of funds from justices' fines de-
posited in the general county fund of said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The use of forty-two thousand six hundred
2 eighty-six dollars seventy-six cents by the county court
3 of Hancock county, in prior years, from justices' fines de-
4 posited in said county's general fund and representing
5 the difference between the gross revenue from fines and
6 forfeitures collected in and around the unincorporated
7 town of Weirton, Hancock county, West Virginia, and the

8 net proceeds of such fines and forfeitures, is validated.
9 Any unexpended balance of said justices' fines and for-
10 feitures shall be transferred by the court to the general
11 school fund of the county, effective as of the date of this
12 act.
