AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter seventy-five, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session one thousand nine hundred forty-three, entitled "An Act authorizing the state road commission to release to the federal government the state's claim for damages to roads and highways caused by construction of the Tygart River Reservoir, and permitting sale of adjacent land by state agency."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter seventy-five of the acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-three, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. *Release of State's Claims for Damages*

2 *Caused by Construction, Operation and Maintenance of*
3 *Tygart River Reservoir; Sale of Lands.*—The state road
4 commission is authorized, in consideration of the convey-
5 ance by the federal government to the state conservation
6 commission of approximately one thousand seven hun-
7 dred thirty-two acres of land adjacent to the Tygart River
8 Reservoir, to release all claims of the state of West Vir-
9 ginia for damage to roads and highways caused by the
10 construction, operation and maintenance of such reser-
11 voir: *Provided, however,* That the conservation commis-
12 sion, state road commission or any other commission,
13 agent or person holding title to said land, is hereby
14 given authority to sell and convey by proper deed of
15 conveyance for a price to be agreed upon, to any former
16 owner of said land or other person, any part thereof
17 not to exceed in the aggregate one thousand acres.
