AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred seven, as amended by chapter one hundred forty-three, acts of the Legislature, one thousand nine hundred thirty-seven, relating to the time for holding terms of Intermediate Court of Kanawha county, West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred seven, as amended by chapter one hundred forty-three, acts of the Legislature, one thousand nine hundred thirty-seven, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. *Terms of Intermediate Court of Kanawha*
2 *County.*—There shall be three terms of said court held in
3 each year, commencing on the second Monday in January,
4 the third Monday in April, and the third Monday in
5 September. Adjourned and special terms of said court
6 may be called and held as provided for special and ad-
7 journed terms of the circuit court.
