## Senate Bill No. 97

(By Mr. Bowling)

[Passed March 5, 1945; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article fourteen, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to commercial feeding stuffs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article fourteen, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

- Section 1. Definition.—The term "commercial feeding
- 2 stuffs," as used in this article, or in any rule or regulation
- 3 authorized thereunder, unless the context otherwise re-

- 4 quires or a different meaning is specifically prescribed,
- 5 shall mean all feeding stuffs used for feeding animals and
- 6 birds, except whole seeds or grains, the unmixed meals
- 7 made directly from the entire grains of corn, wheat, rye,
- 8 barley, oats, buckwheat, flaxseed, kafir and milo; whole
- 9 hays, straws and corn stover, when unmixed with other
- 10 materials, together with all other unmixed materials con-
- 11 taining sixty per cent or more of water.
