# ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 117 

(By Mr. Bowers)

[Passed March 10, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article fourteen, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to board of park commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
That section four, article fourteen, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4 . The board shall consist of not less than three
2 nor more than five members as the council may, by

3 ordinance, determine, a majority of whom shall constitute
4 a quorum for the transaction of business, except as may
5 be hereinafter provided. Each member of said board
6 shall be a bona fide resident of the municipality and
7 shall own real estate within its corporate limits. The
8 council of the municipality may provide either by the
9 ordinance creating the board or by a subsequent ordinance
10 for the appointment of the members thereof by the coun-
11 cil, but unless and until it does so provide, the members 12 of the board shall be elected by the duly qualified voters 13 of the municipality at regular municipal elections. A 14 councilman, if otherwise qualified, may be a member of 15 said board, if the board consists of four or less members, 16 but one such councilman may be appointed by the council 17 and if it consists of five members not more than two 18 councilmen may be so appointed. The term of the board 19 membership of any such councilman so appointed shall 20 continue during his term and until his successor is ap21 pointed or elected and qualified. Membership on the 22 council shall not disqualify any member for election 23 to the board. The terms of other appointed or elected 34 or a freeholder thereof, he shall thereby be disqualified 35 as a member of said board and his office shall thereupon
members shall be for six years, and until their successors have been duly elected or appointed and qualified: Provided, however, That the council of the municipality shall appoint the members of the first board, such appointees to serve, one for a term of six years, one for a term of four years, and one for a term of two years. The ordinance creating the board shall fix the date upon which the terms of such board members shall begin. When any member of the board, during his term of office, shall cease to be a bona fide resident of the municipality become vacant.
