AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine, article three, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as last amended, relating to the employment of the state supervisor of colored schools and other assistants and employees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section nine, article three, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as last amended, is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 9. *State Department of Public Schools; Super-*

2 *visor of Colored Schools.*—For carrying into effect the  
3 provisions of this chapter, the state superintendent of  
4 schools shall maintain a department of public schools at  
5 his office at the state capitol, and he shall have authority  
6 to employ assistants and such other employees as may  
7 be necessary, including a state supervisor of colored  
8 schools.
