**Senate Bill No. 197**  
(By MR. BURGESS)

[Passed March 7, 1945; in effect July 1, 1945]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article one, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the powers of the state board of control.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section five, article one, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. *Rules and Regulations.*—The state board of  
2 control is authorized to make rules for the proper execu-  
3 tion of its duties and powers. It shall also have the  
4 power to adopt rules and regulations for the govern-

5 ment of the institutions named or referred to in section  
6 three of this article and for the administration of the  
7 financial and business affairs of the institutions named or  
8 referred to in section four of this article, and shall therein  
9 prescribe, consistent with the provisions of this article,  
10 the duties of the persons connected with the management  
11 of such institutions. When any of the guards, attendants,  
12 or other employees in the institutions mentioned in this  
13 section are uniformed, the state board of control shall  
14 prescribe the design, or designs, of the uniforms, which  
15 designs shall be dissimilar to the design of the uniform  
16 worn by the members of the department of public safety  
17 and, when the institution is located in, or in close prox-  
18 imity to, a municipality, no such guard, attendant or  
19 other employee shall wear the cap or caps designed by the  
20 board as part of the uniform, when not actually on duty  
21 connected with his employment, nor shall such munici-  
22 pality adopt for its police officers or other employees a  
23 uniform which is similar in design to the uniform adopted  
24 by the board.

25 Any person violating the provisions of this act shall

26 be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be  
27 punished by a fine of not more than ten dollars, or by im-  
28 prisonment for ten days, or both.
