## Senate Bill No. 200

[Originating in the Senate Committee on Education]
[Passed March 9, 1945; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact sections one, one-a, one-b, and one-c, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to membership, eligibility, term of office and organization of county boards of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
That sections one, one-a, one-b, and one-c, of article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

Section 1. Members; Non-partisan Elections. - Each

6 political party affiliation. No more than two members
7 shall be elected from the same magisterial district.
Sec. 1-a. Eligibility of Members.-No person shall be
2 eligible for membership on any county board of educa-
3 tion who is not a citizen, resident in such county, or who
4 accepts a position as teacher in any school district, or
5 who is an elective member of any political party execu-

6 tive committee, or who becomes a candidate for any
7 other office than to succeed himself.

8 No member of any board of education shall be eligible

9 for nomination or election to any public office, other than

11 on the board has been terminated at or before the time
12 of his filing for such nomination for, or appointment to,

13 such elective public office.

Sec. 1-b. Term of Office.-At the general election in
21. at which their successors in office were elected.

22 The terms of newly elected members shall begin on 23 the first day of January next following the general 24 election at which they were elected.

Sec. 1-c. Organization of Board of Education.-On the
2 first Monday of January, following each biennial general election, each respective board of education shall organize

4 and elect, for a two-year term, a president from its own
5 membership and report same promptly to the state
6 superintendent of schools.
7 All previous acts or parts of acts, to the extent that 8 they are inconsistent with the foregoing provisions of

9 this act, are hereby repealed.
