AN ACT authorizing and directing the state treasurer to apportion between the city of Huntington and the board of park commissioners of the city of Huntington the share of the city of Huntington in the special fund for aid to municipalities in receipts from the state liquor commission as provided under section nineteen, article three, chapter sixty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended and reenacted by chapter seventy-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-one, relating to the disposition of receipts of the state liquor control commission in part for reimbursement of municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The state treasurer in apportioning money
2 in the special fund for aid to municipalities established

3 under section nineteen, article three, chapter sixty of
4 the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred
5 thirty-one, as amended by chapter seventy-one, acts of
6 the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hun-
7 dred forty-one, shall hereafter apportion that part of
8 said fund allocated to the city of Huntington and pay
9 one-tenth thereof to the board of park commissioners
10 of the city of Huntington and nine-tenths thereof to the
11 city of Huntington.
