House Bill No. 167

(By MR. BALLARD of Monroe)

[Passed February 18, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-k, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the terms of the circuit courts of the counties of Pocahontas, Greenbrier, Monroe and Summers, composing the eleventh judicial circuit, and the time for the commencing and holding of said terms.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-k, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1-k. *Eleventh Circuit.*—For the county of Pocahontas, on the second Tuesday in March, and the first Tuesday in June and October.

4 For the county of Greenbrier, on the third Tuesday in

5 April, the fourth Tuesday in July and the second Tues-
6 day in November.

7 For the county of Monroe, on the first Tuesday in
8 April, the second Tuesday in July, and the third Tuesday
9 in October.

10 For the county of Summers, on the second Tuesday in
11 January, and the second Tuesday in May and September.
