AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-n, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the terms of the circuit court in the fourteenth judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-n, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

Section 1-n. *Fourteenth Circuit.*— For the county of
2 Braxton on the second Monday in March, July and No-
3 vember.

4 For the county of Clay on the first Monday in February,
5 June and October.

6 For the county of Gilmer on the fourth Monday in Feb-
7 ruary, June and October.

8 For the county of Webster on the second Monday in
9 January, May and September.
