(By MR. KIDD)

[Passed March 7, 1947; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT making an appropriation out of the treasury, state fund general revenue, for the purpose of compensating Thelma McFerrin for losses sustained by her in consequence of the wrongful death of her husband, Newsom McFerrin, resulting from the negligence of the Weston State Hospital.

WHEREAS, Due to the negligence of the Weston State Hospital, Newsom McFerrin, the husband of Thelma McFerrin, lost his life; therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Appropriation for Thelma McFerrin.*—It appearing from a statement of the revenues and appropriations for the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred forty-six — one thousand nine hundred forty-seven, that there remains in the treasury, state fund general rev-

6 enue, revenue in excess of the amount hereby appropri-
7 ated, there is hereby appropriated from the treasury,
8 state fund general revenue, the sum of three thousand
9 dollars to Thelma McFerrin, to compensate her for losses
10 sustained by her in consequence of the wrongful death
11 of her husband, Newsom McFerrin, resulting from the
12 negligence of the Weston State Hospital.


Sec. 2. *Finding of Moral Obligation.*—It is hereby de-
2 clared to be the finding of the Legislature based upon its
3 conclusion of fact that the appropriation made in section
4 one of this bill is for a public purpose and for the payment
5 of a moral obligation of the state of West Virginia.

I certify that the foregoing act,
having been presented to the Governor for
his approval, and not having been returned
by him to the House of the Legislature in
which it originated within the time pro-
scribed by the constitution of the state, has
become a law without his approval.
