[Passed March 5, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Marion county,
West Virginia, to grant and convey to the Marion County
Four-H Camp Association a tract of eight and a fraction
acres, situate in Lincoln district of said Marion county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Marion County Board of Education Author-*
2 *ized to Convey Land.*—The board of education of Marion
3 county, West Virginia, is hereby authorized to grant and
4 convey a tract of land containing eight and thirty-one
5 hundredths acres, more or less, situated in Lincoln dis-
6 trict of said Marion county, to the Marion County Four-H
7 Camp Association, for a nominal consideration, the same
8 being the real estate heretofore conveyed to the said board
9 of education by the Marion county court under deed of
10 April twentieth, one thousand nine hundred forty, and

11 of record in the office of the clerk of the county court of
12 Marion county, West Virginia, in deed book number three
13 hundred fifty-eight, at page two hundred twenty.

Sec. 2. *President of Board Empowered to Execute*
2 *Deed.*—The President of the board of education of Marion
3 county is hereby authorized and empowered to execute
4 a deed granting and conveying the real estate hereto-
5 fore described on behalf of said board of education of
6 Marion county.
