## House Bill No. 411

(By Mr. Eagle, by request)

[Passed March 6, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Summers county to transfer funds, realized from the assessment and collection of head taxes on dogs, to the general county fund, for the use of said county court in the employment, operation and maintenance of a dog catcher in Summers county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- Section 1. Summers County Court Authorized to
- 2 Transfer Funds to be Used for Employment, Operation
- 3 and Maintenance of a Dog Catcher.—The county court of
- 4 Summers county is hereby authorized and empowered
- 5 to transfer any and all necessary money, from the fund
- 6 realized from the assessment and collection of head taxes
- 7 on dogs, to the general county fund to be used for the pay-
- 8 ment and satisfaction of all expense in connection with

- 9 the hiring, operation and maintenance of a dog catcher in
- 10 Summers county, to be selected by and operated under
- 11 the direction of the said county court.
- 12 All acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent herewith, are
- 13 hereby repealed, in so far as they may apply to Summers
- 14 county.
